Vickie L.S. Smith M.Ed, BDV

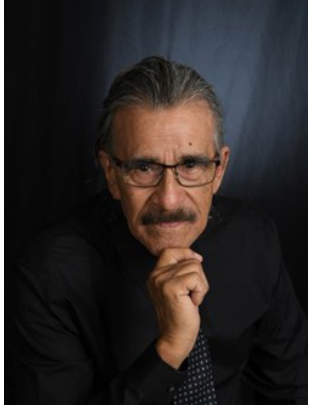

John Martinez

John Martinez is an unpretentious man who loves God. He could be identify with Juan Diego who was chosen by Our Lady of Gualupe. John does not seek attention nor takes credit for all the signs and wonders God has performed through Juanito. John is a Vietnam Combat Veteran 1967-1968. He has always had in his heart the need to help people less fortunate.

One early morning his wife had a rude awaking pointing to a physical man praying at the feet of Juanito. He was dressed as a Monk. Later he found out it was Padre Pio. This was the start of his calling from God. He had emptiness in his soul. He was seeking peace and his purpose in life. Becoming frustrated with himself John left the Catholic Church to find God. After several weeks of prayer around 3:00 am he was praying to God the Father. In his prayer God the Father came to him in a beautiful celestial mist of love and peace.
